

Dormitory Electrical Appliance Safety Guidelines

<Gangneung Dormitory>

1. Permitted Electrical Appliances

- (Refrigerators) 50L capacity or less

☞ Only KC-certified products are allowed / Old or damaged appliances are not permitted / Refrigerators must be reported to the dormitory office upon move-in before use

- (Personal Electronic Devices) Mobile phones, Laptops, Tablets, Power banks

☞ Only KC-certified products are allowed / Old or damaged devices are not permitted

- (Personal Electrical Appliances) Power strips, Hair dryers, **Hair straighteners(v)**

☞ Only KC-certified products are allowed / Old or damaged devices are not permitted

(★★) Hair straighteners are permitted only if they include an automatic power-off function and must be reported before use

♣ Important Notes (★★★)

- ① (General) Only KC-certified electrical appliances are allowed in the dormitory

Appliances showing signs of deterioration(such as discoloration, damage, or unusual noise) **must be stopped immediately**

- ② **(Hair straighteners) must have an automatic power-off function to be permitted**

※ (★★) Refrigerators and hair straighteners **must be reported when moving in before they can be used.**

2. Prohibited Appliances

- **Heating devices**, such as Electric heaters, Electric stoves, Electric blankets, Heated cushions
- **Cooking appliances**, such as Electric kettles, Electric cookers, Electric frying pans, Toasters, Hot plates
- **High-heat appliances**, such as Irons, Mini ovens, Air fryers
- Any other electrical appliance that the Dormitory Director determines to pose a fire hazard may also be prohibited.

☞ These items are not allowed in the dormitory due to high fire risk.

3. Power Strip (Outlet) Safety Guidelines

- Do not use old, damaged, or overheated power strips. (Only KC-certified power strips are permitted)
- **Stop using the power strip immediately if you notice Dust accumulation, Discoloration, Swelling or deformation of the case**
- Do not overload power strips with excessive electrical devices. (turn off the power immediately if you detect burning smells, smoke, or overheating)
- turn off the power switch or unplug the power strip when not in use

4. Charging Devices and Battery Safety

- Mobile phones, Laptops, Power banks, E-cigarettes may be charged only while you are present in the room.
- **All charging devices must be unplugged when leaving the room**
 - ☞ For your safety, refrain from charging devices while sleeping
 - Stop using the device immediately if you notice Dust accumulation, Discoloration, Battery swelling or cracking (should then be disposed of or replaced immediately)
 - ※ Chargers and charging cables must be undamaged KC-certified products, E-cigarettes are also included in battery safety management due to battery overheating risks

5. Personal Appliance Safety

- (★★) **Prohibited electrical appliances must never be used** in the dormitory
- (★★★) **hair dryers or hair straighteners must be turned off after use**
 - ☞ Turn off or unplug the power strip

6. Inspections and Consequences

- **Regular and random inspections** of electrical appliance use in the dormitory will be conducted by dormitory staff and the resident student council

※ If prohibited electrical appliances are found

- Demerit points will be issued, and the appliance will be immediately confiscated or removed from use
- Repeated violations or failure to comply with instructions may result in eviction according to dormitory regulations

☞ **These measures will take effect starting from the Spring Semester of the 2026 academic year**

7. In Case of Fire

- In case of fire or smoke, immediately turn off all power, report to the dormitory or duty office, and evacuate promptly if instructed

8. How to Use the Outlet Fire-Extinguishing Patch

Instructions for Using the Fire-Extinguishing Patch



01 Clean the outlet surface of dust and moisture



02 Peel off the patch



03 Stick it to the center of the outlet
