Merit Point Items	Points
1. Reporting an emergency promptly or accompanying someone to the emergency room.	5
2. Serving on the Resident Council or assisting with Hall management.	3
3. Participating in volunteer activities in the Residence Hall	3
4. Attending events organized by the Residence Hall or the Resident Council.	3
5. Participating in fire evacuation drills.	3
6. Submitting blood donation certificates (Up to 3 per semester)	3

Demerit Point Items	Points
1. Causing a fire (by negligence or intent)	Expulsion
2. Violence, theft, gambling, or trespassing (climbing over walls/fences), including verbal abuse or threats.	Expulsion
3. Committing sexual misconduct or harassment	Expulsion
4. Accompanying someone of the opposite sex into the hall, or entering a residence building designated for the opposite sex.	Expulsion
5. Entering or exiting through windows or by other dangerous means.	Expulsion
6. Smoking indoors (rooms, bathrooms, stairs, hallways, etc.), including e-cigarettes.	Expulsion
7. Opening or helping others enter through unauthorized doors.	20
8. Entering through the night-duty staff.	15
9. Damaging residence hall facilities, equipment, furniture, or other property.	15
10. Causing disturbances due to excessive drinking.	15
11. Changing rooms without permission.	15
12. Accessing the rooftop without permission (except for emergencies).	15
13. Bringing in or using prohibited items (flammables, cooking appliances, unauthorized heaters/electronics).	12
14. Smoking outside of designated areas (In front of D8 and behind D9)	10
15. Leaving the room in an unsanitary condition during the semester or upon move-out (e.g., dirty bathroom, uncollected trash).	10
16. Drinking alcohol inside/outside the Student Residence Hall (including basketball court, outdoor benches, etc.). Finding alcohol bottles will be treated as drinking and result in immediate disposal.	10
17. Bringing unauthorized visitors for entry, meals, or overnight stays.	8
18. Lending access cards or student IDs to others.	8
19. Causing noise disturbances (shouting, loud music, gaming, or voice calls).	7
20. Using laundry facilities after 24:00 (Midnight)	6
21. Refusing to comply with instructions from Residence Hall staff or Resident Council members.	5
22. Littering or improper disposal of waste (vomit, public urination, etc.) in or around the hall.	5

24. Engaging in fire-risk behaviors (e.g., leaving electrical appliances/devices unattended).	5

28. Failing to attend fire drills or orientation (either online or offline).	3

※ Demerit points are accumulated and applied only within the same academic year.

※ If the accumulated demerit points reach 20–24 points, the student will be prohibited from applying to the Residence Hall for one year in the following academic year.

If accumulated demerit points reach 25 or more, or if a student violates any rules subject to expulsion specified in the Merit and Demerit Point List, the case will be reviewed by the Committee. This may result in permanent expulsion and a ban from reapplying.

※ Residents with outstanding merit points may be selected to receive scholarships and priority consideration for Residence Hall admission.

※ After offsetting merit and demerit points accumulated from the opening date of the 1st semester to the closing date of the 2nd semester in the 2026 academic year, the top three male and top three female residents with the highest net merit points will be selected.
